New CPIM Pricing

As we approach the new year we want to take this time to update you on public pricing and additional details for the updated Certified in Production and Inventory Management (CPIM) program. A partner announcement recently was issued noting that the CPIM program will be reconfigured to better serve the needs of the supply chain workforce.

Those who have begun and wish to complete the CPIM series as it currently stands will have until December of 2018 to accomplish this.

1. CPIM will be a Learning System allowing for instructor led, flipped classroom or self-study.
2. The Learning System anticipated launch date is August of 2017.
3. The suggested certification process for candidates will decrease from 18 months to 9 months.
4. The program will no longer have windows. Both North America and Outside North America exams will be on-demand.
5. There will be global pricing for the Learning System.
6. Bundle pricing for the exams and courseware will be available for APICS PLUS members.
